I believe we have an issue at UNAM with Siddhartha Mondragon Rrodriguez who has listed you as a potential complaine. It is with great hesitancy that we email. I ask for you to receive this email confidentially and transmit to no one but yourself (because it has your manuscripts in revision in the google drive and your personal data). The Dean of our school is cc'ed.

The issue stems over a grant submitted in the Texas-Conacyt Scheme, and pilot data that I developed with Siddhartha. Attached you will find the grant at different stages. Siddhartha did not have permission to submit the grant. Our relationship deteriorated due to his girlfriend vandalizing my house and he damaging my surfboards ([see pdfs emails](#)). I have edited various papers of Siddhartha with you as a co-author. Including your paper titled: "[Tau, Amyloid Beta and Deep Brain Stimulation: Aiming to Restore Cognitive Deficit in Alzheimer's Disease](#)", "Tau" published as a book chapter, and sections of Papers which resulted in: <https://doi.org/10.3389/fncel.2018.00121> and <https://doi.org/10.1016/j.neuroscience.2018.12.042>. I am acknowledged in some of these papers. The editing at various stages can be found in the google drive below. As you know Siddhartha is a post-doc in Mexico, Siddhartha is not a native English speaker/writer and Siddhartha sought me out (see who initiates emails) to edit in exchange for authorship. I am now an assistant professor at the University of Sydney. I did the editing in exchange for authorship, as a full author on the author-list, not for acknowledgment.

I edited Siddhartha's work in 2015 and 2016 as he indicated he would include me as an author. This fact is conveyed in our correspondences. As you can tell he did not include me as an author.

The above concerns our issue and Siddhartha misrepresenting my ability to be an author with you. He misrepresented your position. This issue does not matter to us and we only bring it up because Siddhartha has been trying to cause trouble. We would like to suggest the following below.

Issue from Siddhartha

Siddhartha has indicated a collaborator at Texas A&M has a concern over something. Siddhartha has not informed us WHO nor the concern. Siddhartha has also indicated his collaborators have a concern over our publications, but has not indicated WHO. Siddhartha first said this grant was submitted in Jan 2016, but that cannot be accurate because of the correspondences (More likely 2017). Siddhartha did not have permission to submit the grant. Unfortunately, due to the closed system in Mexico, we can not get information. Did you submit this grant with Sid? He has your supporting information on the grant I edited. Are you aware of the dispute? Do you have an issue with us? George Perry does not have an issue with us. George Perry is searching his grants to help see if it is indeed him. He is not aware off hand. He knows nothing of the dispute. Can you confirm anything of this?

We unfortunately can not initiate a compliant at his home institution as it is fraught with corruption and mismanagement. We would like to keep the senior professors out of any dispute (Prof. Perry, You - Prof Williams, my senior professors). We would like also to keep published work out of it (Your published work, our published work). Therefore, we might initiate by asking you: Do you see an issue?

We greatly appreciate your correspondence. We want to be absolutely unequivocally clear: we have no qualms with you whatsoever nor do we want to unduly influence you or create any harm/hardships for you. We only wish for Siddhartha and the trouble he has caused to go away (Siddhartha has initiated an "unofficial compliant" of which we can get no information), otherwise we would not bring up our authorship issues.

Could we please correspond with you at your earliest convenience. Hopefully you can shed some light on the facts.

Our resolution

After Professor Perry gets back to us. I would like to initiate with a Conversation between Yourself (Prof. Williams), Myself, Professor Perry, the Dean of the School here, and my Boss.

If we are all on the same page----

We would like to see if we can get a letter written to the effect that: No one has an issue with any of the research published by our mutual groups. Siddhartha is the only one who has an issue. Signed by all parties.

In 2015 he wrote to me about applying for a TAMU-CONACYT grant and wanted my support. I connected him with Ian Murray, formerly of TAMU and I have a record that he contacted Dr Balais. I have no record that he applied.

The grant i edited specifically indicted:

Available resources. Dr. Williams laboratory at Douglas institute has all the equipment necessary to perform these experiments. Similar experiments combining whole-cell and field recordings in combination with optogenetics in the whole hippocampus preparation in vitro and in vivo are being performed in his lab. These experiments are being funded by two 5 years CIHR grants until 2015.

This is to get information to confirm the grants submitted and get a cease and desist against Sid.

Professor Perry does not have a recollection of grants submitted by Sid. Therefore, if he submitted it with Professor Perry name that is evidence of the malfeasance. That brings the number of instances to at least 3 we know of.

I can only find Professor Perry's name in the manuscripts.

I look forward to speaking with you. I would suggest Professor Williams can have a look first.

Director Varela,

1) Please see attached formal Compliant against Siddhartha Mondragon Rodriguez at UNAM. (Our signatures are missing because Siddhartha has fabricated documents, email addresses and likely signatures, based on our email evidence).

- 2) Please see attached email from Professor Williams about Siddhartha submitting a manuscript WITHOUT consent!
- 3) Please see attached email from Professor Perry acknowledging Siddhartha DIDNOT submit grants with him.
- 4) Please see the details of grants Siddhartha submitted WITHOUT the consent of Dr. Francis Manno (word document)!
- 5) We are in communication with Professors Williams, Perry and the Texas A & M University Professor Ian V. Murray, now at Grenada. We are in communication with Texas A & M University and the University of Texas at San Antonio. Siddhartha fabricated a researcher he named Dr. Balais - french for mop - to submit grants with - we have more information concerning this (See Perry email). We have several more communications concerning these issues. These communications are the tip of the iceberg.
- 6) We note OUR complaint will be continued in Texas, Montreal and Hong Kong at the respective universities, lodged with CONACYT, and delivered to consulates of USA, Mexico, and Canada 48 hours after receipt - without response. We will hold financially liable those members of the committee who initiated the "issue" (Pavel, deLafuente, Varela, Ataulfo, and others), whatever it is, we dont know since we have no letter, without evidence - we only have you molesting Barrios. We suggest you correspond with me as Professor Barrios does not have the authority to represent myself or CityU HK or any entity outside Mexico. See email from Barrios agreeing. The City University of Hong Kong has told Prof Barrios several times since June, to NOT participate in committees which do not abide by NIH ORI standards. You and YOUR committee have not abided by ORI guidelines. We note, any deviation, as you and Ataulfo have done is considered unethical. We have indicated to Barrios it is our DUTY to report what you and UNAM have done to the ORI case manager concerning all those named involved (Pavel, deLafuente, Varela, Ataulfo, and others). Therefore anything he has said previously is of his own accord
- 7) We find it very unfortunate these issues for UNAM, but ultimately as *Yourself (Director)* can be heard saying in our meeting (See audio recording), we are trying to **prevent** this from becoming embarrassing for UNAM. I have personally spoken to Professor Orozco about these issues, and so have you. Please note, Siddhartha is not cced. We are NOT trying to embarrass him. We suggest you have a talk with Siddhartha soon since he initiated these proceedings, as we will escalate legally. As I can be heard saying in the recording with you and Dr. Ataulfo: "Im not involved in many of the issues Siddhartha has allegedly indicated." On the contrary, I voiced my concern that Siddhartha does NOT have authority to submit any grant with my name on it and further more, all data collected during this time was the property of Sarael. Therefore, in this logic, as acknowledged by Barrios and Sarael, my connection to these "issues" is tenuous.
- 8) We note as of today: 8.1) No formal complaint from Siddhartha has been lodged against anyone (Formal complaints are delivered in **writing** as our formal complaint has been delivered to you, dictated by ORI). 8.2) No evidence meeting any standard set by ORI-NIH has been revealed of wrongdoing on our part. 8.3) The only evidence of wrongdoing is the behavior of Sid - see emails submitting manuscripts and grants without consent. 8.4) The secret 'Stalin' committee meeting you organized, which has not written a letter (as indicated by Barrios) has been occurring without consent, without following appropriate Guidelines, and has been threatening Barrios since May. We note, it will stop within 48 hours, or we will proceed.
- 9) Please be discrete: We have preemptively contacted the ORI, we have contacted editors, informed Ethics committees at several universities and many individuals have received the same email I sent Williams and Perry.
- 10) Seven individuals are Bcced here. I will cc them your response.

Dear Ethics Committee,

Attached you will find our formal compliant against Dr. Siddhartha Mondragon Rodriguez and a formal cease and desist against any ongoing committee held in secret, with no written record, nor recordings, and no presentable evidence. Here we present a concerted document from four Prestigious universities to obtain a cease and desist against Siddhartha Mondragon Rodriguez. Evidence of this “secret committee” can be heard on the audio recording between Drs. Manno, Varela, and Ataúlfo Martínez on June 18th, 2019: https://drive.google.com/open?id=15-KC_3oXZe1gQoS4n9qdAHQ0fbaJAzGg. This issue with Siddhartha has been going on since May 2019.

Outline:

The following Memorandum is undersigned by **Drs. Francis Manno, Condon Lau, Sylvain Williams, George Perry**, and Including the Dean of Biomedical Sciences at City University of Hong Kong, Chair Professor **SH Cheng**, representing the complainants to an ongoing process at INB UNAM Queretaro, Juriquilla Mexico. The “secret committee” process is closed door, reveals no information and has only interviewed personal internal to UNAM. We are abhorrently antithetical to the manner and way the process has occurred.

- 1) **We demand the “secret ethics committee” abide by ORI-NIH ethics guidelines.**
 - a. https://ori.hhs.gov/sites/default/files/42_cfr_parts_50_and_93_2005.pdf
- 2) We demand all complaints be open and formal.
- 3) We demand records of all complaints with our names.
- 4) We demand a cease and desist about ongoing investigations without evidentiary standards outlined in ORI guidelines.

Nature of dispute:

Siddhartha did not have **confirmation** or **authorization** or **rights to the intellectual property** to submit a grant using pilot data, preliminary data, completed data, any information or written information or “Ideas” from Professors Williams, Manno or Perry or any of the undersigned. Siddhartha did not have **confirmation** or **authorization** or **rights to the intellectual property** to submit a manuscript using data or written information from Professors Williams and Manno. The grant was supposedly devised by these professors (Perry and Williams) and edited by Dr. Manno and submitted in 2016/2017 by Siddhartha without authorization or consent. Dr. Manno edited grants and manuscripts containing this information

under the assumption and by information conveyed by Siddhartha to Dr. Manno in 2015 and 2016, indicating an opportunity to collaborate and publish with Professors Perry and Williams.

- 5) This above we know NOW is FALSE, Siddhartha has misrepresented the positions of Drs. Manno, Williams and Perry.
- 6) We demand immediate release of all information submitted in the names of the undersigned held by UNAM INB, within 48 hours.
- 7) We demand a cease and desist of Siddhartha Mondragon Rodriguez submitting documents, manuscripts or other scientific information using our names. We demand this confirmation in writing.
- 8) We demand the immediate revocation of the privileges giving Siddhartha Mondragon Rodriguez the ability to submit manuscripts, grants and documents in an unauthorized and unsupervised manner, including by not limited to data and information relevant to the undersigned.

Origin of dispute with Dr. Perry:

Dr. Perry requests to see the documents submitted with his name by Siddhartha covering the period 2015 to present. Dr. Perry indicated that Siddhartha contacted him about applying for a TAMU-CONACYT grant and wanted the support of Dr. Perry. Dr. Perry indicated that he connected Siddhartha with Dr. Ian V Murray, formerly of Texas A&M University (TAMU) and he has a record that he contacted Dr Balais. Dr. Perry has no record that Siddhartha applied. Currently we can not find Dr. Balais in Pubmed/Google Scholar. Balais means mop/broom in French. We have contacted Universities in Texas and none can confirm Dr. Balais exists.

Origin of dispute with Dr. Williams:

Dr. Williams requests to see the documents submitted with his name by Siddhartha covering the period 2015 to present. Siddhartha submitted a manuscript without the authorization of Dr. Williams. Professor Williams indicates NO more articles/manuscripts or grants should be submitted by Siddhartha containing data or information derived from the lab of Dr. Williams. Dr. Williams absconds from collaborating further with Siddhartha. The most recent transgression of this lack of consent when submitting occurred in 2019 in the Neuroscience paper <https://doi.org/10.1016/j.neuroscience.2018.12.042>, where Siddhartha did NOT possess authority to submit the manuscript on behalf of Dr. Williams. See Dr. Williams email.

Origin of dispute with Dr. Manno:

Dr. Manno requests to see the documents submitted with his name by Siddhartha covering the period 2015 to present. Siddhartha and Dr. Manno got in an argument in the winter of 2016 about money concerning damage to Dr. Mannos house and surfboards. They were not in communication after the summer winter 2017 because Siddhartha Damaged Dr. Manno's Surfboards https://drive.google.com/open?id=17gPahtl1jurUb_bcZRpXeVMRWcc1nhHC (See emails). Siddhartha and Diana (DIANA YURIDIA organista juarez), the girlfriend of Siddhartha at the time, vandalized Dr. Manno's house that Diana was renting. The damage to the surfboard and the damage to Dr. Manno's house caused the dispute to escalate.

The argument stemmed from the fact that Dr. Manno edited the following documents below and Siddhartha misrepresented that Dr. Manno could be an author on the esteemed papers with Drs. Perry and Williams. Siddhartha misrepresented the position of Dr. Williams and Dr. Perry. Further, Siddhartha submitted grant(s) as indicated above without the approval/consent of Dr. Manno. Dr. Manno began to disagree with Siddhartha Mondragon Rodriguez when he begun publishing in predatory journals acknowledging his name. Journals listed on Bealls List (<https://beallslist.weebly.com/>).

The issue at hand:

- 1) Siddhartha submitted a grant using Dr. Manno's name and data unknowingly. We seek immediate release of this information from Conacyt and UNAM. See grant preparation.**
- 2) Siddhartha submitted a grant/manuscript using Dr. Williams name and data unknowingly. We seek immediate release of this information from Conacyt and UNAM. See grant with Dr. Williams name sent to Dr. Manno by Siddhartha.**
